

FREE CODING WORKSHOPS

Dear Parents,

In a previous weeks Newsletter, we transmitted a proposal from Google Atelier Belgium for a series of free extracurricular workshops at Google Digital Atelier (Brussels) for Brussels European Schools' pupils.

When enrolment opened at 10 am on 1 May 2019, it appeared that the demand was very high, with more than 800 pupils interested in following a workshop, and a number of pupils were on waiting lists.

In the meantime, we've been informed that the Office of the Secretary-General of the European Schools (OSGES) agreed with Google Digital Atelier to organise 16 summer sessions in July-August 2019 to give the opportunity to another 480 pupils to participate.

There will be morning and afternoon sessions held on the following dates:

- 9-10 July 2019
- 16-17 July 2019
- 23-24 July 2019
- 06-07 August 2019

Priority will be given to pupils who are on the waiting list and were unable to secure a place in the workshops organised in May-June 2019.

Pupils currently on the waiting list will receive an e-mail from the organisers on 23 May 2019 informing them of these new dates. Registration for these new sessions will open on Saturday, 25 May 2019.

Furthermore, we've been told that Google Digital Atelier will also regularly organise free workshops open to all (not reserved only for the European Schools). There is a clear need to develop this type of workshops and digital activities for European Schools' pupils and students, both in and out of school. Communication will be provided by the APEEE in due course.
